Are You Sitting Comfortably?


One of my students recently asked me about the height of her piano stool at home. It's really important to be sitting high enough at the piano. If you're currently using a kitchen-style chair, it's probably too low. You should never be reaching up to the keyboard, and practising in this position will likely lead to poor development of technique. Piano stools are expensive, but you will do just as well with any height-adjustable stool.


Also, ensure you're not sitting too close to the piano – your knees should <u>only just</u> be under the keyboard, and if you straighten your arms and learn forward a little from the hip, your fists should just be able to touch the piano lid/music stand. If your arms bend, you're too close!
